

Voting Rights in Colorado

- A 17-year-old can vote in a primary election as long as you are 18 by the general election
- A 16-year-old can pre-register to vote
- Guardianship does not remove the right to vote
- Photo ID is not required
- You are allowed to vote online if you have a disability and require online voting to access your ballot
- Every Voting Service and Polling Center must be ADA accessible
- Early voting is available to everyone
- Mail Ballot Voting is available to everyone who is registered to vote
- Mail Ballot Drop Boxes are available for dropping your mail ballot without postage

You have the right to vote privately and independently.
